Dear Current and Future School Parents:

We are delighted to announce that registration for our Hebrew Year 5771 and academic year 2010-2011 school programs has begun. The school year 5770 was a wonderful success, and we intend to continue learning right where we left off.

Our Pre-School program, consisting of 8 2-hour sessions during the year, is open to the children of members as well as non-members, ages 3-5. It is quite common, and most welcome, for children to attend our Pre-School program for more than one year. Our Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Grades are open to the children of both members and non-members alike. Our Religious School (3<sup>rd</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> grades, Aleph-Hey) is open only to Temple Israel members' children.

**\* Incentive registration discounts!** Religious School (Kitah Aleph – Kitah Hey Only) registration forms received by June 30, 2010 receive a **\$50 discount!** Before registration forms will be accepted, **any outstanding school or other balances due Temple Israel from 2009-2010 or before must be paid.** No registration form will be processed or discount applied if there is a prior balance on your Temple Israel bill. **No registration form will be processed without the appropriate tuition fee.** All tuition balances must be paid by **December 31, 2010.** Since some of our grade levels are nearing or at capacity, late applications may not give us enough time to hire appropriate staff for additional classes. Please be considerate and register as early as possible. **THE EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT CANNOT BE COMBINED WITH THE FAMILY MAXIMUM DISCOUNT.**
